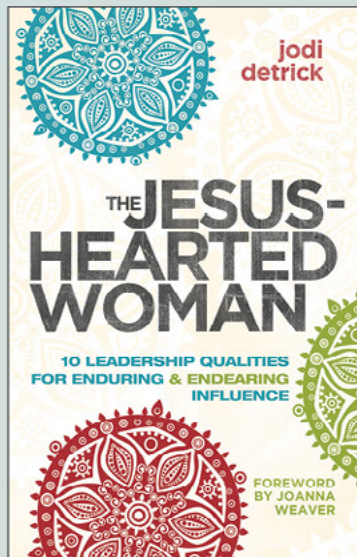

Introduction

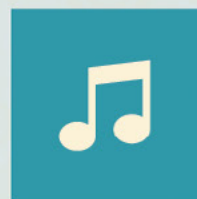
Conclusion

Sending International Students to Bible School



REENA came to Christ while she was in college in India. When she told her family she was following Christ, they disowned her. She said, “I did not see my mother and father for over 10 years, as they refused to have anything to do with me. It hurt deeply, but what could I do? I cannot leave Jesus!”

Because of Reena’s newfound faith, she felt a call to attend Bible college, but finances were very low. In many other cultures of the world, especially male-dominant cultures, a woman who feels a call to full-time ministry struggles with the finances or opportunities to attend an approved Bible college.

Scholarships for International Students (SIS) provides funds to help women with a call to ministry to attend Bible college.

Reena received a scholarship from SIS to finish Bible college. She married a pastor; she and her husband now pastor two groups of believers and lead a village school. Hundreds of lives have also been affected through Reena’s ministry. Reena is an example of a life that was profoundly touched by receiving a SIS scholarship to attend Bible school.

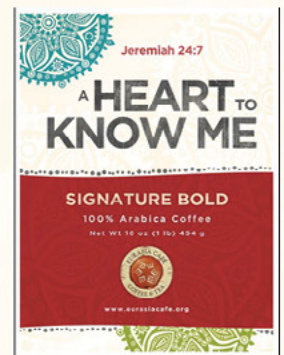

MEET DEBBIE FARAH

A first generation Palestinian-American, Debbie leads Bajalia Trading Company. Her goal is to help women around the world to become self-sustaining as they design products for an international market.

After a life-transforming mission trip experience, Debbie knew something needed to be done to empower women and to change the poverty she encountered on the trip. Thus began her journey to begin Bajalia Trading Company.

God took Debbie's design expertise (executive roles with Bloomingdale's and Neiman Marcus) and banking background (the youngest vice president in the American Banking Association) and called her to dream bigger. Today Debbie's passion is "Restoring hope through economic development; bringing God's love and healing to women in need."

Maybe you recognize **DEBBIE FARAH** from the Home Shopping Network, but her journey of becoming a Jesus-hearted woman who dreams big started with just an idea. When I first met Debbie, she had just moved to Dallas, Texas, to work for Neiman Marcus. She was clearly very creative. She had a wonderful eye for design and putting things together, whether it was entertaining in her home, coordinating flowers for a wedding, or overseeing an advertising layout for work. Through her, I saw how God can work through our talents when we let Him.

When God first called Debbie to begin Bajalia Trading Company, many people thought she was crazy to leave a lucrative career to pursue an unconventional ministry. Back then, no one really talked about fair trade. But sometimes that's how God moves, to show how much He loves women who don't feel loved. God called Debbie to walk away from a secure paycheck and bring hope where there is no hope. The most amazing part is that she obeyed!

As a result of her obedience, Debbie has shared the gospel in places where missionaries aren't allowed. When I traveled to Asia with Debbie, I was most impacted by how this ministry frees women out of human trafficking. When brothels consider women to be no longer economically viable, they allow them to be sold. I thought this happened to older women, but the reality is that at about 19 years old, women are sold from the brothels. When I realized that not only

women, but also children are taken into human trafficking, my heart broke. For these women, making jewelry with Bajalia Trading Company isn't only a livelihood, it also helps them heal.

God has given Debbie favor with others too. I watched customs officials treat Debbie respectfully because they know she helps give women a sustainable future and a job with dignity. These officials aren't believers; they're Muslims and Hindus, but Debbie's example of God's love really impacts them. They know Debbie invests in these women, helping them to choose commercially viable designs for an international market. Rather than stay caught in poverty, these women are then able to work from home, passing on their love of the arts to the next generation.

Watching God reach others through Debbie's obedience has challenged me to ask:

1. *What big dream does God have for me to do? Am I really open to obeying Him like Debbie is?*
2. *How willing am I to step out of my comfort zone? I say I want to help other people, but how am I really doing that for God?*
3. *What can I do right now? It doesn't always take a career change to help other people and show them God's love in a tangible way.*

JANA KOOP lives in Irving, Texas, where she attends Fellowship Church with Pastor Ed Young. Jana works for Citigroup in information technology for the tax department, employed by the New York offices. Her hobbies include cycling, making jewelry and reading. Jana is active in the singles group of her church, and has gone on missions trips to China and Thailand with Debbie Farah, as well as serving on medical missions teams to Belize.



MEET JANAЕ DAGEN who committed her life to following God's calling at a young age. Through mission trips, God awakened her heart to the injustice in the world and stirred within her a love and passion to seek hope for the broken.

Janae gained experience in marketing and tourism as she continued to yearn for a longer-term missions experience. As newlyweds, Janae and her husband Ryan began to dream of opening a café and hostel where they could serve the local community and give proceeds back to global causes. As they prayed, God led them to Eurasia Café.

Since joining Eurasia Café, Janae has had the privilege of seeing God align her passions for missions with her experiences and education. In her role at Eurasia Café, Janae is privileged to help those who want to serve coffee and tea with a life-changing purpose.

The Need

Consider the needs of the women in your community

Today's woman experiences many pressures—to prepare for a profitable career path; to find the right husband; to be the perfect wife and mother; to enjoy her career and still care for the majority of the household chores; to be appropriately feminine, yet confident and assertive. Some are facing physical challenges. Many are single moms. Others are caring for aging parents or grandchildren. Some of these women feel they are responsible for too many roles and powerless to change their circumstances.

Our declining economy adds additional stressors to an already overwhelming load. With the breakdown of the family and positive support systems, many have made poor choices and are experiencing ongoing, negative consequences.

All of these pressures can keep them disconnected from other women, creating feelings of isolation.

It is these women who walk into our churches looking for relief and hope. They are longing for deep relationships and spiritual support to help them stand against the stresses of everyday life.

Most women are extremely relational beings. We generally process and resolve our emotions by talking through them, usually with another woman or group of women. Most of us have the ability to share our emotions quite openly, and we communicate to build relationships and express ourselves. Understanding these characteristics can help us know

how to better minister to the women in our lives.

Effective ministry to women includes:

- Presence
- Understanding
- Compassion
- Meaningful conversation
- Godly examples

We need to build a community of women where healthy one-on-one relationships can flourish!

Women thrive in an environment of encouragement and support. Those who have experienced the love of God should be ready and equipped to share that love with others. Understanding the needs of today's woman can help us create intentional, relational, strong ministry to women.

The Culture of Your Ministry to Women

Every ministry has a distinct culture—it is the intangible atmosphere or environment that dramatically influences the way things are done and the effectiveness of ministry. Culture is shaped over time by shared beliefs, attitudes, values, goals and practices. If we desire to minister effectively to women, we must be committed to creating an atmosphere where life-giving relationships can flourish.

So how is the culture of your ministry to women? If you want to improve the atmosphere, here are some things to remember:

1. The truths we present at big events or small groups will impact the culture. Make sure to teach personal responsibility for developing a Christlike character and healthy relationship principles.
2. Encourage every woman to have a variety of relationships—relationships with peers, as well as with older and younger women, and with those who are outside of the church.
3. As leaders, we influence the culture in many other ways: the way we interact with women in the hallways, the ideas we share in conversations, the hospitality we offer in our homes, our responses to difficulty or conflict, and the way we treat our families. Our responses impact the culture, even more than what we share in formal presentations.

May we all strive to be Jesus-hearted women!

There is not a one-size-fits-all approach to ministry to women. Your strategy should be tailored to meet the distinctive needs of the women in your church and community.

When your vision, strategy and culture are healthy and operating, everyone from an established member to the first-time visitor will be able to recognize your team's passion for ministry to women.

Discover the Vision
(Proverbs 29:18, KJV)

As a leader of ministry to

women, you should seek to understand the established vision of your pastor and church leadership. Take time to pray and fast while discovering the unique expression of that vision for the women in your church.

Build a Team
(Ecclesiastes 4:9, NLT)

A unified team is very important for any effective ministry. The vision may come from the leader, but the strategy should be discussed and perfected with a team of women. Understand the women who make up your team. Each has individual strengths—strengths your team needs to be successful. Build healthy relationships with your team. Together you have a greater impact than any one person alone!

Understand Change
(Colossians 2:6–8, NIV)

At times, we cling to events or programs for tradition's sake, even though it may not align with the vision of the church. Do not be discouraged if you sense others are resistant to change—but instead, take time to communicate with the women on your team and create an atmosphere where your team can ask questions and receive understanding.

Develop a Strategy
(Colossians 1:18–20, MSG)

When you begin to create a strategy, consider what the end result should be. Once you've developed a strategy, start goal-setting with your team. Focus on what you should “stop doing” as well as what you should “start doing.” A ministry that does a few things well is more impactful than one that does many only halfway.

3-D Design

The Three-Dimensional Design will help you minister to women through three levels of interaction—**Big Events**, **Small Groups** and **One-on-One Connections**. Whether your church is large or small, this model can be modified and implemented to meet the unique needs of the women you are called to minister to.

BIG EVENTS

Big Events Theme parties, meal events, rallies, retreats or conferences are examples of Big Events that can invite, include and inform all of the women in your church and community. Ideally, these gatherings would take place two to four times each year.



SMALL GROUPS

Small Groups can be as diverse as the interests and needs of the women in your church. These groups can involve and instruct women, providing fellowship and mutual support for life's journey. As relationships are strengthened over time, small groups can provide care, accountability and encouragement that women need.



ONE-ON-ONE

While Big Events and Small Groups are important, the most effective ministry happens in **One-on-One** ministry. We must be intentional about creating an environment for healthy relationships to flourish. We should encourage every woman to have a variety of relationships—every woman benefits from having relationships with her peers, as well as those who are more experienced or less experienced. Life-giving, one-on-one connections are vital for the emotional and spiritual health of women.



An Expression of Women's Ministries is Compassion



As we live in full devotion to God, He will give us opportunities to reveal His love in life-changing ways. God wants us to connect with and encourage our hair stylist, grocery clerk, family members and the underserved in our community.

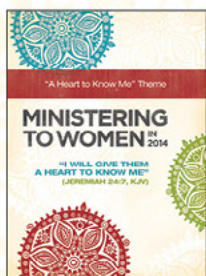
He wants us to be aware of the needs all around us. God also gives us unique opportunities to serve those in need around the world.

A healthy ministry to women will include many opportunities to express the love of God to others. We can offer opportunities for community outreach or engagement on a regular basis. Here are just a few ideas to spark your creativity:

- Collect and distribute gift cards for back-to-school purchases
 - “Adopt” residents at a local care facility
 - Hold an appreciation dinner for local police and fire fighters
 - Sponsor a coat or clothing drive
 - Adopt-a-school or classroom
 - Host a spa day for single moms or the underserved
 - Send care packages to deployed military
 - Distribute seasonal food boxes for the underserved
 - Provide cold bottles of water at a community event
 - Support the projects presented in this publication: Scholarships for International Students (SIS), the *A Heart to Know Me* Cuff Bracelet, and Eurasia Café (on pages 10-13)
 - Involve women in world and U.S. missions projects as well, either through praying, giving or going as a team
- The list is endless!
